SJIS Is Closing on September 30, 2018

At an SJIS Special Meeting of its Information Service Representatives (ISRs) on August 25th, in Moorestown, NJ, the ISR's voted to approve the Board's recommendation to close SJIS.

SJIS's closure was not due to financial difficulties. SJIS was unable to recruit members willing to serve on its Board in the positions of President (Chair), Treasurer, and Secretary as required by NJ state law.

At the meeting, all acknowledged those who had previously served as ISRs, on Board/Steering Committee, as Event Chairs, and Webmaster. These volunteers and members were assisted by Shirley, our special worker for over 13 years. Their service, and the generous financial support of the groups, enabled SJIS to serve them and the public for many decades.

SJIS's Board will begin the legal process of paying its bills, cancelling services/subscriptions, carrying out a review of its finances, and filing its dissolution documents with the State of NJ and the IRS.

- SJIS's Office will close on September 21, 2018. Until then the office will be open Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 10am-3pm.

- Donations will be accepted until September 21, 2018.
- After all taxes and liabilities have been paid, the net assets of SJIS will be distributed, as per the SJIS bylaws, in equal shares to NJ Assembly, Jal-Con, NJIS, and Al-Anon World Service Headquarters.
